2017 Humanitarian Award

Petersburg DeMolay Chapter is pleased to submit the following activities for consideration for the 2017 Humanitarian Award:

November 23, 2016 – Petersburg DeMolay assisted Petersburg Lodge #15 in serving Thanksgiving Dinner to about 100 Fort Lee soldiers who were not able to go home for the holidays. Four DeMolays and four Advisors worked two hours each serving the soldiers and cleaning the tables. **Total of 16 manhours.**

January 20, 2017 – Petersburg DeMolay assisted an Eagle Scout in constructing a flag burning retirement pit at Robert E. Lee Post of the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Colonial Heights. Two DeMolays and one Advisor provided a total of 10 manhours in this effort. **Total of 10 manhours.**

February 11, 2017 – Petersburg DeMolay cleaned up trash and debris around Fort Davis, a part of the Petersburg National Battlefield Park. Three DeMolays and two Advisors worked one hour each. **Total of 5 manhours.**

April 1, 2017 – Petersburg DeMolay held a carwash to raise funds for the Children's Cancer Fund and a New Kent DeMolay family who had lost their home in a fire. Four DeMolays and five Advisors worked two hours each in this activity and raised a total of \$180. **Total of 18 manhours and \$180.**

These activities represent a grand total of 49 manhours and \$180 collected during the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017.
