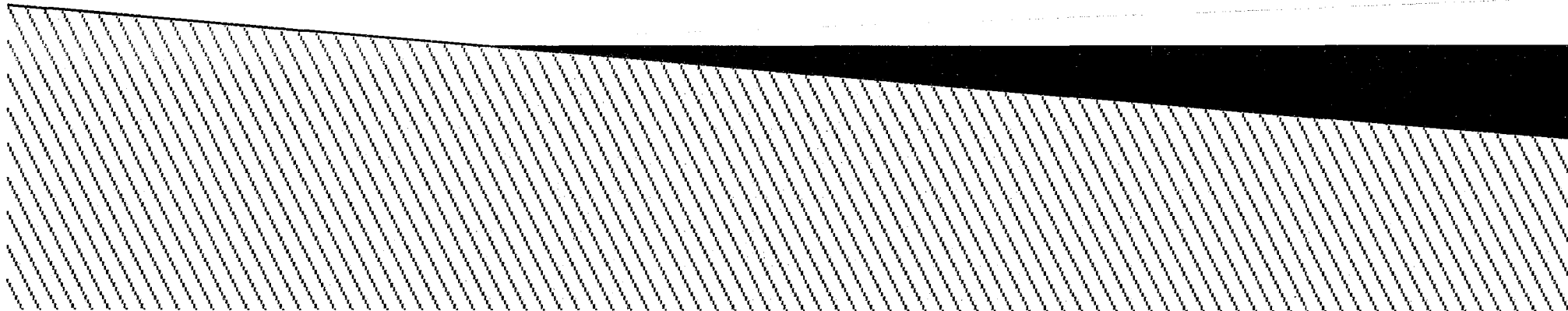

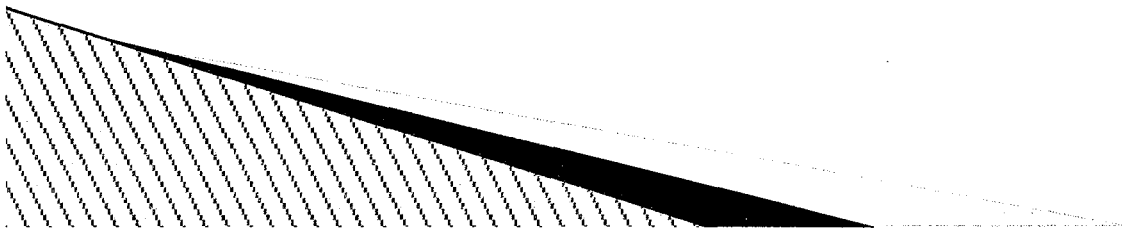
Relay For Life

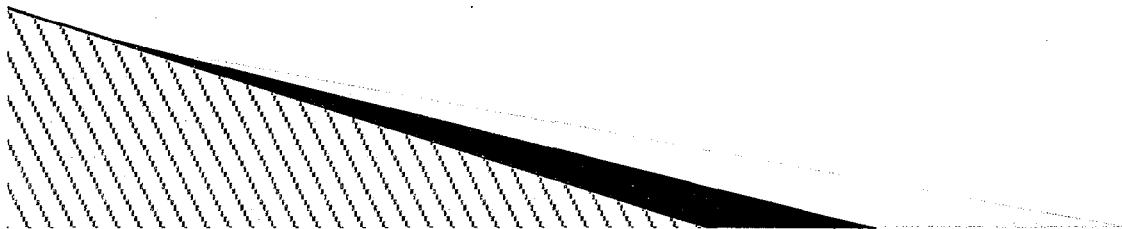
Special Olympics

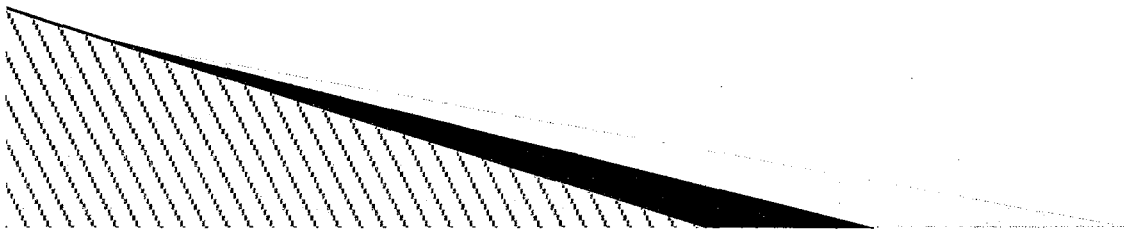
Mom Russel's
